



Own a piece of London's Art Deco heritage

A rare relief wall art panel from 1930's London, part of the heritage collection of Frank Holmes Fine Decor

A limited edition Art Deco wall art panel capturing the elegance of London's Derry & Toms department store on Kensington High Street, which later became Barbara Hulanicki's world-renowned fashion store Big BIBA. Designed by Walter Gilbert in 1933, founder of The Bromsgrove Guild, which was also famed for creating the main gates at Buckingham Palace. The original bronzed design was installed above the store's lift doors and one original panel is now preserved in the V&A Collection.

This panel is a meticulous reworking of the highly stylised original and depicts a forest scene of grazing gazelles with birds in flight surrounding a central fountain. The iconic 'frozen fountain' design, a cascading stream of water seemingly frozen in time, is a powerful symbol of eternal life and immortality.

Carefully handcrafted in white, or cold cast using a range of metals.
